This source-list is based upon that given in English Ritual Drama by E.C.Cawte, Alex Helm and N.Peacock (Folklore Society, London, 1967), with all additions known to us at present.

The list is far from complete, and further 'editions' will be produced when necessary. Similar research in Hampshire has produced more than double the number of entries for that county given in English Ritual Drama, and it seems likely that the same can be achieved for Wiltshire, given time.
